FSC Baltic meeting in Latvia 8 – 10 March 2017

Background

This is a meeting in a Swedish Institute financed project. The project aims to strengthen the network between the FSC offices in the Baltic and Nordic countries and to cover some current issues in relation to bioeconomy. The main area chosen is the implementation of the Bird and Habitat directives in relation to the development and implementation of the FSC forest management standard. In this meeting BirdLife representatives are invited as being part of the environmental interests in FSC. A next meeting is planned in the end of August in Estonia and will also include certified forest owners and authorities responsible for the directives.
